



Pilot test of the INFUSSE Virtual Incubation Programme for Digital Entrepreneurship in national level







Three "Virtual Incubator" pilot programs – one in each partnering Higher Education Institution area (Greece, Romania, Poland).



The course encompass 25 hours of e-learning activities, distributed over five days with approximately 5 hours of learning per day.

Days 1-2 – e-learning course: INFUSSE Platform

Days 3-4 – trainers consultations

Participants have the opportunity to work on their presentations and consult them with trainers. All the presentations have to include:

- The problem the business is solving.
- Solution (the product/service)
- Target market and opportunities.
- Competition.
- Marketing strategy.

- Business model.
- Finance (optional)
- Future Perspectives (optional)

Day 5 – Demo day

Before participation in the Demo day event all students should have completed all requirements:

- Reach 100% on INFUSSE Platform (both in %viewed & %completed indicator)
- Proof of attendance. All participants need to take a printscreen during the platform course and declare that they have attended all the 5-day program. You can create a google form to collect all this information.
- Complete the 7 quizzes that are uploaded in the platform.
- Email or upload the pitch presentation
- complete the questionnaire about their experience in the project.
- Participate in the online sessions.
